**Disciples Go Fishing:** A look at the Great Commission

**Objective:** The whole body of Christ has been called to “go and make disciples”.

• **How did the Lord shape you into a disciple?**

**Read:**

Great crowds were following Jesus. He turned around and said to them, "If you want to be my follower you must love me more than your own father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters — yes, more than your own life. Otherwise, you cannot be my disciple. And you cannot be my disciple if you do not carry your own cross and follow me. "But don't begin until you count the cost... Luke 14:25-28 NLT

• "If you want to be my follower you must love me more than..." **Is your love only focused on your direct family? Is your love focused only on you?**

• **What is a disciple?**

**Read:**

Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will catch men." Luke 5:10b

So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him. Luke 5:11

• **What's keeping you from following Jesus?**  
• **To leave everything and follow... what does this mean in your daily life? At work? At home?**

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. Matt 28:19-20

*I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. John 14:12*
